We, your VBBA Board of Directors, share the sentiment expressed by Virginia Beach Mayor Bobby Dyer that May 31st was "... the most devastating day in the history of Virginia Beach. People involved are friends, coworkers, neighbors and colleagues." We offer our deepest condolences and prayers to the families of those who lost loved ones, those who were injured, and all those affected by this senseless tragedy. We commend our local and state law enforcement, first responders, medical personnel and all others who acted swiftly in response to the event.

For those of us who have lived or worked in Virginia Beach for any length of time, we know that although statistical data may designate us as a large city, our community is still very much a small town. Because of the closeness of this community, it seems like all of us have family, friends, coworkers, neighbors or colleagues who were directly affected by this tragedy. We are heartened to see the community's outpouring of love and support to all those affected.

Several of our members have contacted us to inquire how they might assist the families who suffered such tragic losses on May 31st. The City of Virginia Beach has created a website, www.loveforvb.com which lists all vigils and public memorial services scheduled in support

of the families, as well as volunteer opportunities and other general information for those in our community who wish to show their support. For those desiring to provide financial support, the United Way of South Hampton Roads has set up a special, dedicated fund called the Virginia Beach Tragedy Fund for the victims and their families. 100% of the proceeds raised will go to the victims and their families. clerk's office on May 9th, 2019. They provided Duck Donuts, coffee, and tea to the clerks. A great time was had by all.



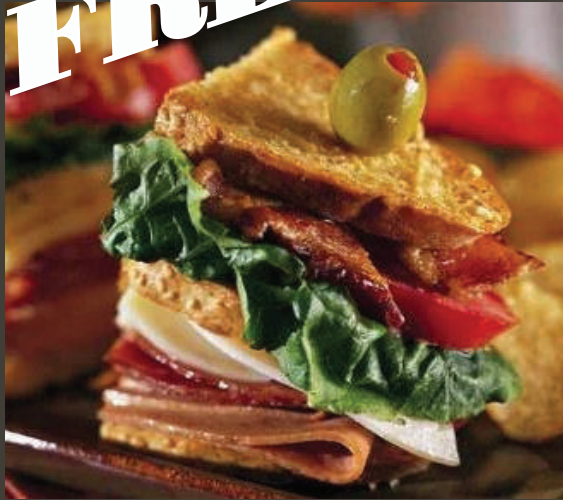
